

CVRC GENERAL MEETING

July 8, 2014

1. There were 17 folks present.
2. The meeting started at 7:35 pm.
3. President Dale started with a Show and Tell. 1st came Barry Whittemore who showed us two unique code keys. Then Dale showed us the detector circuit of an LED transceiver project which is a joint venture with Ernie Gray and Steve Jones. Noted that all project info comes from Clint Turner, KA7OEI. More info can be Googled on the internet.
4. The Treasurer gave her report indicating funds expended on food for Field Day. Some funds were collected for membership, as well. The overall report is that the Treasury is healthy.
5. The Secretary, Steve Jones, gave his report.
6. A joint motion was made, seconded, voted and passed to accept both reports.
7. Larry Beagle, Field Day Co-Chairman, gave his preliminary report. He indicated we, in total achieved about 5,352 points, but a final tally is not ready. Also, the total number of QSO's will also be ready soon, but they are, at this time, estimated to be over 2,000.
8. In comparison, Barry Whittemore reported that the Granite State Radio Assoc. had about 1,034 QSO's.
9. The White Mountain Radio Club operated 2A out of the Conway, NH area. There scores will be reported soon, as well.
10. A motion was made, seconded, voted and passed, to approve the \$215 expended for the rental of the tent, whereas one which we used to borrow from Larry Damour is no longer available. The club members moved, seconded, voted and passed that up to \$400 could be expended for a used tent from the same place where we just rented one in Hollis, NH. We will be in touch with them about that, as soon as convenient. We may have to wait till Fall time to come to an agreement on an available unit and its final price. Naturally we want it to be one that is used but in good shape.
11. Noted that 21 people, so far, have signed up for the picnic. This will be coming up soon, on July 26th.
12. It was agreed that we would do a Fox Hunt and antenna testing at the picnic. There is a threat to play a "Pin the Tail on the Dale" game, horse shoes, etc.
13. Jeff Shaw reported that the club trailer was totally reorganized inside. Thanks to Jeff, Jenn and Alaina for all their help in this work, and in the forthcoming picnic, as well.
14. Noted that the GOTA station at Field Day went very well, this year.
15. Noted that the National Night Out Against Crime will again be coming up. It will be on Aug. 5th. Our club operating time will be (setup in the afternoon at about 2:00 pm) then on the air from 5 to 8:00 pm.
16. Also noted that the 10 GHz contest is on Aug. 16th and 17th.
17. At the Aug. 12th meeting, Steve Jones, N1JHJ, will give his presentation on 2 meter beam antennas.
18. Dave Connor will once again host the Exec. Board meeting on Aug. 22nd.
19. Noted that Dave Perrin will be selling several antennas soon. You can contact him directly.
20. There was a motion made, seconded, voted and passed to adjourn at 9:06 pm.
